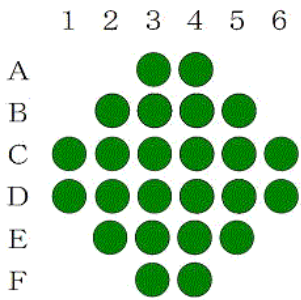
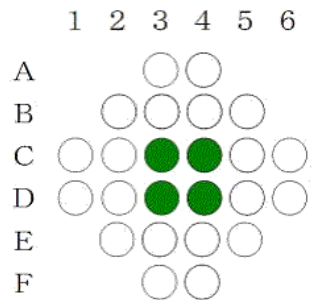


Peg Solitaire Deformed Diamond

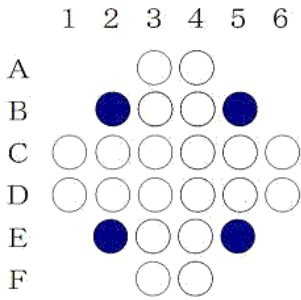
Deformed Diamond 24



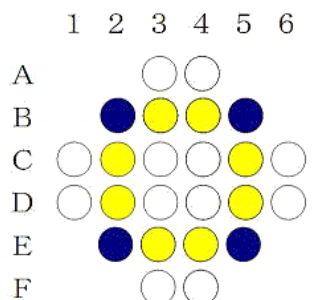

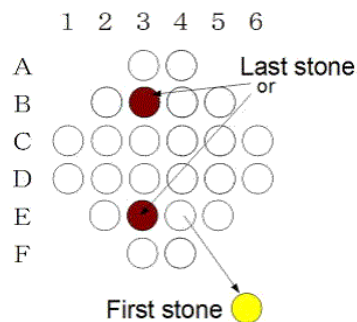
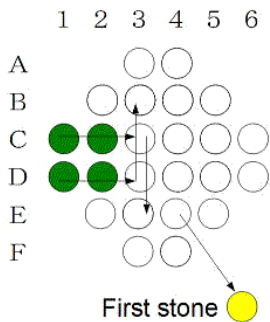
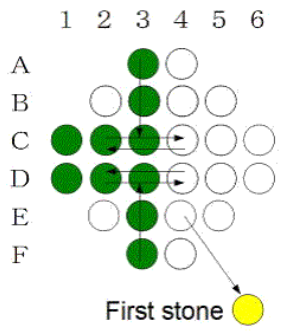
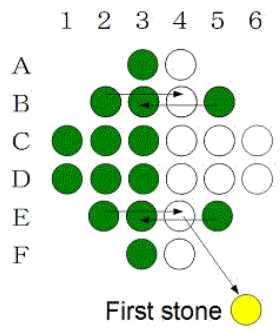
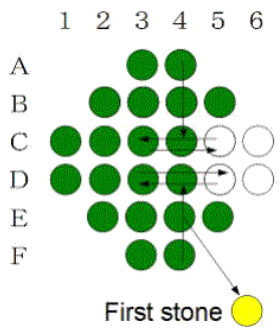
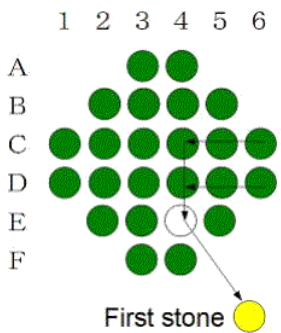
Therefore, at last, only one of four Blue stones shown in a left chart may remain.



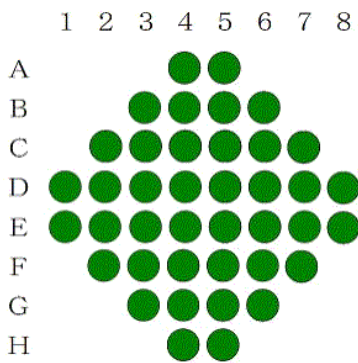
For Virtual rule, please refer to Peg Solitaire French 37. Then, one of Yellow stones as shown in a right chart may be First stone. For example, when Yellow stone E4 is First stone, either of stone B3 or E3 is Last stone.



Example of First stone E4 and Last stone B3 or E3

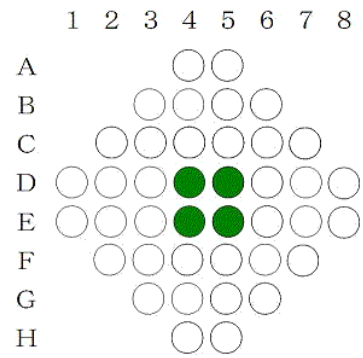


Deformed Diamond 40

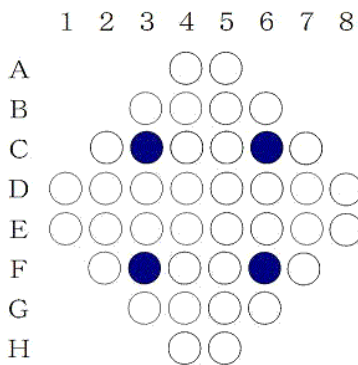


The array of the stones of Peg Solitaire Deformed Diamond 40 is shown in a left chart.

Four Green stones as shown in a right chart remains when Peg Solitaire Deformed Diamond 40 is played by Virtual rule.



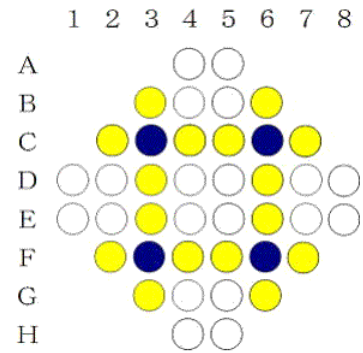
Therefore, at last, only one of Blue stones shown in a left chart may remain.



For Virtual rule, please refer to Peg Solitaire French 37.

Then, one of Yellow stones as shown in a right chart may be First stone.

Therefore, when Yellow stone D6 is First stone, H either of stone B3, B6, E3 or



E6 is Last stone.
