
First stone as shown in a left chart, either of Green stones C1 or C4 is Last stone.





# Square 49




The array of the stones of Peg Solitaire Square 49 is shown in a left chart.



Then, one of Yellow stones as shown in a left chart may be First stone.




Therefore, when Yellow stone D5 is First stone, either of stone A3, A6, D3, D6, G3 or G6 is Last stone.


#### Example of First stone D5 and Last stone D3 or D6
